We would like to welcome Tomas and Nicolas back to the pre-school after a winter spent in warmer climes, hope they will soon settle back into the pre-school routines. We would also like to welcome our new starter Lucas into the setting.

Over the past few weeks we have enjoyed several walks across the field and we have noticed that the children have showed particular interest in the neighbouring farmer's field. The children have asked "Where are the animals?" "What's happened to the grass?" "Why is it brown?" and "Why are there lots of straight lines on it." We have explained that the land has been ploughed, arrowed and turned ready to plant potatoes. We will be monitoring the progress of the potato plants and looking out for little green shoots. In order to extend the children's interest and knowledge we will be exploring the wonders of "Growth" We will be reading the story of "Jack and the Beanstalk" and giving the children the opportunity to plant and care for their own beans. We will be growing grass in a very large tray and using it as a "real" field for the children to drive the toy tractors over and put the farm animals out to pasture.

23rd April We will be celebrating St George's day by reading dragon stories, acting out a "dragon hunt" and painting dragon pictures.
